ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP

The UTS:INSEARCH Indigenous scholarships are available to students who identify as Aboriginal and /or Torres Strait Islander and apply to study at UTS via the *Jumbunna Direct Entry Program*. This allows the student to choose one of six UTS:INSEARCH diplomas. Scholarships range from \$27,000 to \$34,000, depending on the diploma chosen.

Qualifying students will receive one-on-one help from tutors and have access to support services at UTS.

Recipients may receive additional support including book vouchers, computer resources, and public transport assistance. This will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis.
